Please first call the medical institution at which you would like to have an examination if you have symptoms (such as sudden fever or cough) that are indicative of influenza. If you are diagnosed by a medical institution as having symptoms that are suspected to be those of an infectious disease, such as influenza, then you will be instructed as to where and when your medical examination will be conducted – the designated time will be such that you will not be in close contact with other patients of the hospital. Please follow the instructions that you are given regarding your examination.
